All entry fee checks or money orders (US funds) are to be made payable to CAPER. One check is sufficient for all enclosed entries.

Entries must be received by **6 pm CDT Wednesday September**, after which time no entries may be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted. No telephone or verbal entries will be accepted. All changes and cancellations must be received in writing (email is acceptable) prior to closing, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows published by the American Kennel Club.

All entries must be on official AKC entry forms. Entries will be returned if they are illegible, incomplete, are submitted with incorrect fees, or are photocopied without the reverse side instructions and agreement included. Checks returned for insufficient fees will have the entry cancelled; acceptance of such an entry will only be made if the full fees, plus a \$25 administrative fee, are paid via certified check or money order & received prior to the start of judging. Express & certified deliveries must include signature waiver permitting them to be left at the Secretary's address without receipt signature. Entries received without signature release will be refused.

Entries with email addresses will be acknowledged with an email receipt. Confirmations and judging schedules will be emailed after closing. If you want a hard copy confirmation mailed, please note this on your entry. CAPER is not responsible for non-delivery of emails due to delivery errors or spam blockers, and no further efforts will be made

Refunds: Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date; in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by the Event Committee; or in the event that extreme weather conditions, riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the Event Committee make it impossible to open or complete the show/trial. 75% refunds will be made for bitches entered in obedience or rally who come into season after the closing date, if written notice is given to the Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of judging of obedience/rally classes.

Fax/email entries: Entries may be faxed to the Secretary at 206-222-2830, or emailed to secretary@ caper-dogs.com. The full page of each entry form must be included, completely filled out and signed, or the entry will not be accepted. Payment can be made via PayPal or credit card by going to www. caper-dogs.com/PayPalCCpayment.htm and following the instructions there. Payment <u>must</u> include the \$2 per class additional charge to be valid.

Entry errors: Exhibitors are responsible for the correctness of entries. All entries which include an email address will be sent an entry verification email shortly after receipt. All errors will be corrected prior to closing; exhibitor errors discovered after closing cannot be corrected. Overpayments of less than \$5 per dog will not be refunded.

Transfers: Dogs which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, or higher level in Junior Showmanship, Obedience or Rally, after the closing of entries for these events may be transferred to the higher class. Each of these transfer requests must be made to, and accepted by, the Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of judging. accepted by, the on-site Show Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of judging for that day.

Best of Breed

Non-Regular Classes (single dog entries)

Veterans all three specialties, Working classes in National Specialty ONLY

Veteran Dogs, 7 yrs & older Veteran Bitches, 7 yrs & older Entrants may be altered. Winners eligible to compete for Best of Breed.

Working Dogs Working Bitches

Entrants must have a CDX, a tracking title, a herding trial title, or Std AND JWW agility titles. Entrants must be intact. Winners eligible to compete for Best of Breed.

Non-Regular Classes (multiple dog entries) - Eastern & National Specialties ONLY

Winners of these classes are not eligible to compete for Best of Breed.

Stud Dogs Brood Bitches

Dogs/Bitches (may be altered) shown with two of their offspring.

Class is judged on the merits of the offspring, but the parent will be examined for DQs/excusals.

Offspring must be entered in a regular conformation class.

Entry is made for the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch - offspring are not entered on the entry form.

Brace Class

For two dogs, regardless of sex, performing in unison and presented by one handler.

Both dogs in each Brace must have at least one common owner.

Entrants must be entered in another class.

AWARD OF MERIT: The judge may, at his/her discretion, give Awards of Merit to those dogs who were in final consideration for Best of Breed and were not winners of BOB, BOS, BOW or Selects. The number of awards is determined by the number of BOB competitors: 6-8 in BOB, 1 AOM; 9-12 in BOB, 2 AOMs; 12-15 in BOB, 3 AOMs: 16 & over in BOB, 4 AOMs.

National Owner-Handled Series: The NOHS winner will be selected after Best of Breed judging.

Please specify the jump height for any obedience classes with jumps. The jump height for all Advanced and Excellent rally classes will be 16".

Transfers to higher level classes are allowed in both obedience & rally, in accordance with AKC regulations.

SWEEPSTAKES (Midwest I Regional 10/12 & National 10/13)

Indicate the Sweepstakes class, with the age division, on the entry form in the "Additional Classes" box. Sweepstakes entries must be exhibited by the owner of the dog, a member of owner's immediate household, the breeder, or the stud dog owner. No other handlers may exhibit in sweepstakes. The above rule is also applicable for any dog returning to the ring for Best in Sweepstakes.

Puppy Sweepstakes

Puppy Sweepstakes is open to all Giant Schnauzers who are at least 6 months of age and less than 18 months of age on the day of the sweepstakes. Entrants must be entered in one of the regular conformation classes. Champions of Record may NOT compete.

Puppy Sweepstakes entries <u>must</u> be exhibited by the owner of the dog, a member of owner's immediate household, the breeder, or the stud dog owner. No other handlers may exhibit in Puppy Sweepstakes. The above rule is also applicable for any dog returning to the ring for Best in Puppy Sweepstakes.

Veteran Sweepstakes

Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all Giant Schnauzers who are at least 7 years of age on the day of the Sweepstakes. Entrants may be altered and need not be entered in any other class. There are no restrictions on who can exhibit dogs in Veteran Sweepstakes.

DISTRIBUTION OF SWEEPSTAKES PRIZE MONEY

30% of fees will be retained by Club for expenses. The remaining 70% (for each Sweepstakes, Puppy & Veteran) will be divided among the class placement winners as follows:

First Place - 40% • Second Place - 30% • Third Place - 20% • Fourth Place - 10%.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP (each Specialty)

<u>Novice class</u>: For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, at the time entries close, <u>have not</u> won three first place awards, with competition present, in a Junior Showmanship Novice class at a licensed or member show.

Open class: For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, at the time entries close, <u>have</u> won three first place awards, with competition present, in a Junior Showmanship Novice class at a licensed or member show.

<u>Master class</u>: For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, at the time entries close, have won the 10 Best Junior awards with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 - October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

PLEASE NOTE: Juniors must include their AKC Junior Handler number on the entry blank. Be sure all information for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on the <u>front **and** back</u> of the entry form. Dogs shown in Junior Showmanship may have Full or Limited AKC registration or have an ILP/PAL number. Altered animals are eligible to be shown, but bitches in season are not eligible.

AKC NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

All dogs that are owner-handled and are not owned, co-owned or exhibited by professional handlers* meet the requirements for this competition. Exhibitors must declare their dogs are Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers, household members and assistants to current professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any breed competition during the entire show.

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligibe to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

* Professional handlers are not permitted to exhibit in this competition. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay. or received payment for handling a dog.

JUDGES EDUCATION - Thursday 11am

This seminar is open to those who are interested in judging the Giant Schnauzer and who are currently AKC licensed judges or who have applied to the AKC. The seminar will begin at 11 am with a classroom portion, lunch 12:30-1:30 pm, and hands-on instruction 1:30-2:30 pm.

The cost will be \$25 + \$10 for lunch, checks made payable to: GSCA. Funds must be in U.S. currency. This cost will include a copy of our illustrated standard. A registration form will be available on the GSCA web site at www.giantschnauzerclubofamerica.com.

In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The club, Purina Farms, and any of their agents, or employees will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, & further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

Exhibitors should follow their Veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Dogs found in an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way (for example: left unattended on a grooming table in a noose not attached to a safety release clip; left in a vehicle without proper ventilation) will be removed to safety. Exposing a dog to an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way is considered mistreatment.

RINGSIDE: Dogs may arrive at any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Judges will not wait for any dog. Owners and agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs at ringside when their class is called. The club, judges, stewards and secretary have no obligation or responsibility to announce for or locate dogs that are not at ringside when required.
