## Seminar

Previous experience is not necessary or required. The seminar is broken down into two parts. The first part will consist of a discussion about herding, followed by an instinct evaluation of the participant's dogs. The second part is designed to provide a hands-on setting to understand and start to develop the partnership between dog and handler to move livestock in a safe and controlled manner. Between the 1st and 2nd part of the clinic we will have a lunch provided for.

The seminar starts at 8:00 a.m. and should end around 3:00 p.m. We will be working inside an enclosed arena, however, depending on weather and/or level of dog/handler we may work outside in one of the larger fields. The stock is a mixture of Barbs, Barb crosses and other hair sheep. Stock is dog broke and very workable.

Please bring boots that provide good ankle support, clothes appropriate for the weather, and water for your dog (no water is available at location) and drinks for yourself. The nearest town is approximately 20 minutes away. As soon as I receive your information I will send out a confirmation notice with more information, however, I will contact you immediately if an entry is sent in and the seminar is full.
